ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, the Government approved that estimate of vacancies for the post of Chief Engineer in Public Works Department for the year 2018-2019 as '14' (Fourteen). The crucial date for preparation of panel of Superintending Engineers (Civil) fit for promotion as Chief Engineers in Public Works Department for the year 2018-2019 in Tamil Nadu Engineering Service is 1st April, 2018 and the post of Chief Engineer is being filled up by promotion from the post of Superintending Engineer (Civil) in Public Works Department.

2. As per Rule 5 Branch I - Public Works of Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Engineering Service a Superintending Engineer must have minimum period of one year of left over service before retirement at the time of actual promotion for promotion to the post of Chief Engineer. As per the seniority list, only 6 nos of Superintending Engineers have more than one year of left over service as on date. Hence, the temporary list is restricted to 6 numbers of regular Chief Engineers instead of 14 numbers of estimate of vacancy.

3. In G.O.(Ms.) No.440, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Per.S) Department, dated 26.10.1990, it has been directed that to be eligible for promotion as Head of Department, an officer should have not less than one year minimum period of service before retirement. For those who do not have such a minimum period of left over service

but are otherwise found to be fully qualified, fit for promotion as Head of Department and deserving recognition on the crucial date of preparation of panel shall be compensated by appointing them as 'Officer on Special Duty' with a specific assignment and with the same scale of pay as that of the Head of Department. Subsequently, in G.O.(Ms.) No.631, Public Works (A2) Department, dated 23.10.1997, the nomenclature of 'Officer on Special Duty' was changed as 'Special Chief Engineer'.

4. In exercise of the powers conferred under section 7(1) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby relaxes Explanation III under Section 7(1) of the said Act so as to draw the temporary list of Superintending Engineers (Civil) fit for promotion as Chief Engineers in Public Works Department for the year 2018-2019 in the order of seniority mentioned below:-

5. The names of Superintending Engineers, who have less than one year of left over service, have been examined and they are eligible for appointment as Special Chief Engineers as and when their juniors are promoted as Chief Engineers.

6. Even though certain names are indicated for promotion as Chief Engineers, those Superintending Engineers who have less than one year left over service at the time of actual promotion will be appointed as Special Chief Engineers.

7. The Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department is requested to communicate a copy of this order to all concerned, as required under section 7(1) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016. He shall also instruct the Superintending Engineers, whose names have not been included in the temporary list, to prefer an appeal, if any, in the matter to the Government through proper channel within two months from the date of receipt of this order.
