ORDER

In the Government Order first read above, guidelines have been issued for vertical separation of the Department into Public Works Department and Water Resources Department. In paragraph 9(C) of the said Government Order, among others, it has been ordered that all promotions / appointments from the year 2021-2022 has to be made by the respective Engineer-in-Chiefs of Public Works Department and Water Resources Department by formulating separate seniority list.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued approving the combined temporary list of Assistant Executive Engineers(Civil) fit for promotion as Executive Engineers(Civil) in Public Works Department and Water Resources Department, for the year

2021-2022 consisting of 63 nos. by relaxing paragraph 9(C) of G.O(Ms) No. 158, Public Works Department, dated 1.11.2021.

3. In the Government Order third and fourth read above, 34 numbers of Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) have been temporarily promoted and posted as Executive Engineers (Civil) in Water Resources Department and Public Works Department.

4. In the Government Order fifth read above, the following 13 numbers of Assistant Executive Engineers (i.e., upto Sl. No. 61 in the combined temporarily list who opted to work in Public Works Department) have been promoted and posted as Executive Engineers (Civil) in Public Works Department:-

Consequent on the promotion of certain junior Assistant Executive Engineers in Public Works Department in the combined temporary list for the year 2021-2022, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai in his letter sixth read above, has stated that 13 numbers of Assistant Executive Engineers who opted to work in Public Works Department have been promoted and posted as Executive Engineers in Public Works Department and whereas, 14 numbers of senior Assistant Executive Engineers who opted to work in Water Resources Department have not yet promoted. He has therefore, requested orders of the Government to upgrade 14 numbers of Assistant Executive Engineer posts in Water Resources Department, who are seniors to those Assistant Executive Engineers already promoted in Public Works Department, by prefixing "Special" to the upgraded post, as per paragraph 9(D) of G.O(Ms) No. 158, Public Works Department, dated 1.11.2021.

6. In paragraph 9(D) of the G.O first read above, the Government have ordered as follows:-

*"Paragraph 9(D): **Protection of service rights** of officials in all categories of posts governed by the State level one unit seniority shall be granted on the lines ordered in the G.O. first read above. Accordingly, if*

any junior official in any of the category of the Engineers who are covered under Common Seniority happens to get promoted either in Public Works Department or in Water Resources Department, the pay level of all persons senior to him/her shall be upgraded with monetary benefit with effect from the date on which his/her junior happens to be promoted by prefixing 'Special' to the upgraded post without any additional responsibilities. As and when the actual turn of the person so upgraded comes in the Department he/she serves, he/she may be accommodated in the promotional post and the post upgraded for him/her shall be downgraded to the pre-existing level".

7. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief & Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department and order that the posts held by the following 14 numbers of Assistant Executive Engineers be upgraded as Special Executive Engineers in Water Resources Department, with monetary benefit from the date on which their junior promoted as Executive Engineer in Public Works Department. This upgradation of posts involves no additional responsibilities of higher post:-
