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Bifurcation of our Department

More than 150 years old Public Works Department is now bifurcated in to Public Works Department (Buildings) and Water Resources Department with effect from 01.11.2021. Guidelines are issued in the Government Order Ms.No.158, PWD (D2) Department dated 01.11.2021. Even though the order is expected since the formation of the new Government, this will cause inconvenience to our member Engineers by the way of Redeployment of certain Divisions, Sub Divisions and Sections. The much delayed Promotion Panels may also delayed further citing bifurcation.

A co-ordinated approach is needed by the heads of Public Works Department and Water Resources Department in mitigating the problems faced by our member Engineers on account of bifurcation. The bifurcation is only for administrative convenience, since two ministers are posted for Public Works Department and Water Resources Department. We should think of improving the service conditions of Engineers working in both Public Works Department and Water Resources Department and adopt strategies to spur the growth of the both the Departments.

We should not allow our differences on minor issues and try to continue our unity for the common cause of our member Engineers.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, among others, orders have been issued for the functioning of Water Resources Department and Public Works Department as two separate departments.

2. In the Government Order second read above order have been issued for dividing Public Works Department, Buildings Organization into 3 regions and on the works allotted to the Regional Chief Engineers.

3. In the Government Order third read above, among others, the subject relating to Water Resources Department has been allocated to the Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources and the subject relating to Public Works Department has been allocated to the Hon'ble Minister for Public Works.

4. In the Government Order fourth read above, amendments have been issued to the Tamil Nadu Government Business Rules, 1978 wherein the subjects relating to "Water Resources" which have been already existed under the heading "Public Works Department" have been omitted and those subjects have been inserted under the heading "Water Resources Department", separately.

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5. In his letter fifth read above the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department has stated that as a consequence, the administrative functions of the department have to be separated among Public Works Department and Water Resources Department and in order to facilitate smooth transition of administrative functions among the departments, the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department has requested orders of the Government on the following proposals for stipulating guidelines for the vertical separation of the Department into Public Works Department and Water Resources Department.

- (i) The posts specifically sanctioned to Buildings Organisation and Water Resources Organisation may continue to be attached with the respective Departments.
- (ii) The ministerial posts sanctioned under Chief Engineer (General) may entirely be attached with the Water Resources Department considering the volume and proportion of the works and the large number of staff attached with the Department. The administrative staff predominantly comprising of Junior Assistants, Assistants and Superintendents required to man the general administrative functions of Public Works Department may either be redeployed among the posts available with the Public Works Department or can be newly created as per the requisition of the Engineer-in-Chief, Public Works Department.
- (iii) All further promotions/ appointments from the year 2021-2022 may be made by the respective Engineer-in-Chief of Public Works Department and Water Resources Department by formulating separate seniority lists as per the extant statutory rules. Protection of service rights of officials in all categories of posts governed by the State level one unit seniority may be granted on the lines ordered in the Government order 1st read above. Accordingly, if any junior official in any of the category under the present one unit seniority existing as on 06.06.2021 happens to get promoted either in Public Works Department or in Water Resources Department, all persons senior to him/ her may be granted notional promotion with effect from the date on which his/ her junior happens to be promoted by upgrading the post held by him/ her by prefixing 'Special' to the promoted post without any additional responsibilities. As and when the actual turn of the person so notionally promoted comes in the Department he/ she serves, he/ she may be accommodated in the promotional post and the post upgraded for him/ her may be downgraded to the pre-existing level.
- (iv) Regarding inter departmental movements of personnel in the undivided Department, that officials working in the categories from Junior Engineer/ Assistant Engineer to Chief Engineer have been requested to exercise fresh options within a period of three weeks. They may be permanently deployed either in Public Works Department or in Water Resources Department according to their option which would be final and non-reversible. If the number of officials opted to a particular Department surpasses the number of sanctioned posts in that Department, they may be considered for deployment in either of the Department based on their existing seniority. The existing seniority for the 1997-98 and 1997-99 batch of Engineers is under dispute on the file of

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the Honorable Supreme Court of India. Pending finalization of Seniority, the allocation of Engineers between Public Works Department and Water Resources Department shall be done on tentative basis.

- (v) The personnel in other categories of posts except Engineering Personal may be allowed to continue in the Department where they serve as on 06.06.2021 except in cases where redeployment is necessary on administrative grounds.
 - (vi) The Public Works Staff Training Institute functioning at Chennai, Trichy and Madurai under the control of the Director in the cadre of Superintending Engineer head quartered at Trichy presently serves both Water Resources Organisation and Buildings Organisation. The Training Institutes at Chennai and Madurai may be attached with the Water Resources Department. The Training Institute at Trichy may be directly brought under the control of the Engineer-in-Chief, Public Works Department. The office of the Director, Public Works Staff Training Institute may be attached to the Engineer-In-Chief, Public Works Department to look after the administrative works.
 - (vii) At present 7 Quality Control Divisions are functioning in the Department under the control of the Chief Engineer, Institute for Water Studies, Hydrology and Quality Control catering to both Buildings Organisation and Water Resources Organisation. Among 7 Quality Control Divisions, four Divisions at Chennai, Trichy, Madurai and Coimbatore may be brought under the control of Water Resources Department and the three Divisions at Villupuram, Salem and Tirunelveli may be brought under the control of Public Works Department. The headquarters of these Divisions may be modified to suit the requirements of the Departments concerned according to their convenience for operational.
 - (viii) The Chief Architect wing, Director of Technical Education Wing and the Directorate of Boilers wing may be brought under the administrative control of the Engineer-in-Chief, Public Works Department.
6. In the G.O. sixth read above, the following orders have been issued:
- (i) A separate GENERAL UNIT shall be formed in the office of the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai to deal with all establishment matters of Public Works Department viz., Recruitment, Preparation of Estimate of vacancy, Panel proposals, Promotions, Transfer and Postings, Pay fixation, Disciplinary matters, Retirement, Pension proposals, as per the provisions of existing Statutory Acts and Rules.
 - (ii) The above said General Unit shall function under the control of the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai.
 - (iii) As the order on the bifurcation of the office of the Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai is yet to be issued, till such time for the transfer and postings from among the common category either from Water Resources Department to Public Works Department or from Public Works Department to Water Resources Department the proposal may originate from the respective Engineer-in-Chief.

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7. During the discussion while moving the Public Works Department Demand No.39 in the Legislative Assembly on 27.08.2021, Hon'ble Minister (Public Works) has made the following announcement regarding re-organisation of Public Works Department:-

"An additional Region will be created with Headquarters at Coimbatore by re-organising Chennai and Trichy Regions."

8. The proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai has been examined by the Government and the Government decided that in order to ensure equitable promotional opportunities, there needs to be a re-organization in the current sanctioned strength that a ratio of 32:68 be maintained in Public Works Department and Water Resources Department respectively at all levels from the category of Assistant Engineer to Chief Engineer. As a new region is coming up in Coimbatore for Public Works Department, one Chief Engineer and one Superintending Engineer will be allotted to Public Works Department. Therefore, the sanctioned strength, as per the change in ratio would be as follows:-

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9. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai issue the following orders on the guidelines for the vertical separation of the Department into Public Works Department and Water Resources Department:-

- (A) The Engineers who are covered in common seniority be diverted to Water Resources Department and Public Works Department based on the existing sanctioned strength, including deputation posts, initially and the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer(General), Public Works Department is requested to
- (i) re-work the sanctioned strength on the ratio of 32:68 for Public Works Department and Water Resources Department respectively as detailed at paragraph 8 above;
 - (ii) to identify the posts that are to be transferred between the two organizations as mentioned below:-
- 1 (one) new Chief Engineer post has to be added to Public Works Department which is proposed to be created by re-organisation of Chennai and Tiruchirappalli Regions of Public Works Department
 - 1 (one) Superintending Engineer post has to be transferred from Water Resources Department to Public Works Department
 - 5 (Five) Executive Engineer posts have to be transferred from Public Works Department to Water Resources Department
 - 13 (Thirteen) Assistant Executive Engineer posts have to be transferred from Public Works Department to Water Resources Department and
 - 14 (Fourteen) Assistant Engineer posts have to be transferred from Water Resources Department to Public Works Department
- (B) Ministerial posts sanctioned to Chief Engineer (General) unit in the office of the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai has to be redeployed to the Public Works Department proportionately.
- The nomenclature of the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department shall be changed as "Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department" and the General Unit now functioning under the control of Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department & Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department will continue to function under the control of Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department after redeployment of ministerial posts to the Public Works Department proportionately.
- (C) All further promotions/appointments from the year 2021-2022 has to be made by the respective Engineer-in-Chiefs of Public Works Department

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and Water Resources Department by formulating separate seniority lists as per the extant statutory rules.

The future recruitment to all the vacant posts in Public Works Department and Water Resources Department shall be made separately based on estimate of vacancies arrived at.

- (D) **Protection of service rights** of officials in all categories of posts governed by the State level one unit seniority shall be granted on the lines ordered in the G.O. first read above. Accordingly, if any junior official in any of the category of the Engineers who are covered under Common Seniority happens to get promoted either in Public Works Department or in Water Resources Department, the pay level of all persons senior to him/her shall be upgraded with monetary benefit with effect from the date on which his/her junior happens to be promoted by prefixing 'Special' to the upgraded post without any additional responsibilities. As and when the actual turn of the person so upgraded comes in the Department he/she serves, he/she may be accommodated in the promotional post and the post upgraded for him/her shall be downgraded to the pre-existing level.

- (E) The **Option** exercised by the Engineering personnel belonging to the common seniority, working in the categories from Junior Engineer / Assistant Engineer to Chief Engineer would be final and non-reversible.

If the number of officials opted to a particular Department surpasses the number of sanctioned posts in that Department, they shall be considered for deployment in either of the Department based on their existing Batch Seniority.

The allocation of Engineers between Public Works Department and Water Resources Department shall be done on tentative basis, subject to the outcome of the pending court case before the Supreme Court of India regarding revision of seniority based on merit.

The list of option exercised by Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers, Executive Engineers, Assistant Executive Engineers and Assistant Engineers as on 30.06.2021 to Water Resources Department and Public Works Department are attached as Annexure-I and Annexure-II respectively to this order.

- (F) The ministerial posts and administrative posts shall continue to function under the departments viz. Public Works Department and Water Resources Department, where they serve as on 06.06.2021, subject to the existing rules that are in force.

Regarding mode of recruitment, seniority and interchangeability of posts in ministerial and administrative Staff, their existing status shall continue.

As far as ministerial and administrative staffs are concerned, promotional opportunities to move to the technical side shall be allowed as per the existing rules, subject to the reworked sanctioned strength. The

panel for promotions shall be prepared jointly at the Secretariat, wherever required as per the rules in force.

For the sanctioned posts at Circle level seniority, the seniority is maintained at Circle level only. They shall continue to function under the respective circles as per existing procedure.

The sanctioned posts at One Unit seniority level shall continue to be treated as common cadre. Based on the experience, decision has to be taken after 2 years regarding Bifurcation of administrative and ministerial staff.

- (G) The **Public Works Staff Training Institute** functioning at Chennai, Trichirappalli and Madurai under the control of the Director in the cadre of Superintending Engineer headquartered at Trichirappalli presently serves both Water Resources Department and Public Works Department.

The Public Works Staff Training Institutes at Chennai and Madurai shall be attached with the Water Resources Department.

The Public Works Staff Training Institute functioning at Trichirappalli shall be directly brought under the control of the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings), Public Works Department.

The office of the Director, Public Works Staff Training Institute shall be attached to the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings), Public Works Department.

- (H) **7 Quality Control Divisions** at Chennai (Tharamani), Villupuram, Trichirappalli, Salem, Coimbatore (Pollachi), Madurai and Tirunelveli functioning under the control of Chief Engineer, Institute for Water Studies, Hydrology & Quality control, catering to both Public Works Department and Water Resources Department.

Quality Control Divisions at Chennai (Tharamani), Trichirappalli, Madurai and Coimbatore (Pollachi) shall be attached to Water Resources Department and Quality Control Divisions at Villupuram, Salem and Tirunelveli shall be attached to Public Works Department.

Since the majority of the works of Public Works Department are located in big cities such as Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore, Divisions now at Villupuram, Salem and Tirunelveli be relocated to **Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore** respectively and should be utilized by the Public Works Department and necessary infrastructure including building would be shifted / created.

- (I) The Chief Architect Wing, Directorate of Technical Education Wing and the Directorate of Boilers Wing shall be brought under the administrative control of the Engineer-in-Chief, Public Works Department.
- (J) **Re- classification of Public Works Department Poramboke lands**
All the water courses, water bodies, Eri, Thangal, Canal poramboke, etc., classified as "Public Works Department Poramboke land" shall be re-classified as "Water Resources Department Poramboke land"

(P.T.O.)

All other lands shall remain with the Public Works Department.

(K) **Bifurcation of Electrical Wing**

The Electrical Wing is functioning under the control of Public Works Department with 8 Electrical Divisions with the total sanctioned strength of 215 Engineers .

The Engineer-in-Chief(Buildings) & Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai is directed to send necessary proposal to the Government for splitting the Electrical Wing of Public Works Department between Public Works Department and Water Resources Department in a specific proposition, in consultation with the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department & Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department.

(L) **Ownership of Buildings**

Those buildings which are under exclusive control of Public Works Department or Water Resources Department, ownership shall be transferred to respective departments. The maintenance shall be undertaken by the respective department to whom the ownership is transferred.

Both the Engineer-in-Chiefs of Water Resources Department and Public Works Department are directed to send proposal for taking decision on the ownership of Buildings jointly occupied by Water Resources Department and Public Works Department.

10. The orders at paragraph 9 above shall come into force with effect from the date of issue of this order.

11. This order issues with the concurrence of Human Resources Management Department and Finance Department vide their U.O.No. 32730/E2/2021, dated 20.10.2021 and vide U.O.No. 45820 /P.W.II./2021 - 1, dated 01.11.2021 respectively.

ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, the estimate of vacancy for the post of Assistant Executive Engineers(Civil) in the Tamil Nadu Engineering Service, Branch -I, Public Works for the year 2006-2007 had been fixed as 118 Nos.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued approving the temporary lists of Assistant Engineers / Junior Engineers fit for promotion / appointment for the post of Assistant Executive Engineers(Civil) for the year 2006-2007 consisting of 88 Nos. of Assistant Engineers and 30 Nos. of Junior Engineers and they were subsequently promoted / appointed as Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) in Public Works Department.

3. In the Government Orders third to seventh read above, orders have been issued for restoration of seniority in respect of 4 Nos. of Assistant Engineers and 1 no of Junior Engineer in the posts of Assistant Executive Engineer (Civil) in the respective places.

4. Thiru. S. Manikandan and 8 others who were selected by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in the 1997-1998 batch, have filed Writ Petition No. 46868 of 2006 before the High Court of Madras with a prayer to direct the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission to revise their seniority in the post of Assistant Engineer in Public Works Department as per the practice followed earlier to 1996 in assigning the ranks which was dismissed by Common Order dated 18.10.2012 on the sole ground that the petitioners were guilty of delay and laches.

5. Aggrieved by the above order, the Writ Petitioners have filed a Writ Appeal. The Division Bench of Madras High Court in its Common Order dated 31.3.2015 passed in W.A. No. 2705, 2730, 2731 of 2012, 2394 and 1033 of 2013 allowed the Writ Appeals and directed the official respondents to take the rank assigned by the Service Commission to the selectees, as the basis for fixation of seniority and issue appropriate orders within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

6. The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, preferred SLP (Civil) No. 22094 – 22098 of 2015 (SLP (C) No. 2886 of 2016) against the above order of the Division Bench dated 31.3.2015 in the Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its Order dated 22.1.2016 has held that, "after the emergence of the judgment in *Bimlesh Tanwar*, the

fundamental principle relating to drawl of seniority list was that it should be based on merit list of selection and that the list drawn based on roster point can have no application for the purpose of seniority list. As the said fundamental principle was applied by the High Court in passing the impugned judgment, we do not find any merit in these special leave petitions. The special leave petitions were dismissed".

7. The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has preferred Review Petition on the above orders before the Supreme Court of India and these Review Petitions were also dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 25.8.2020.

8. Certain contempt petitions were filed by the selectees, who were aggrieved by non revision of the seniority list in the Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order eighth read above in Civil Appeal No. 4954 of 2016 and batch cases dated 1.10.2021 has passed the following orders:-

"28. We therefore direct the respondents to revise and publish the seniority list of the selectees, who were selected in the selection process conducted in pursuance of the notification issued by TNPSA dated 10th September 1999, strictly on the basis of the merit determined by it in the selection process and not on the basis of the roster point. The same shall be done within a period of 12 weeks from the date of this order".

9. In compliance of the above Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in the D.O. letter ninth read above, has furnished the revised seniority list of candidates as per merit ordered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, recruited for the posts of Assistant Engineer(Civil) in Public Works Department during 1997-1998, 1997-1999 and 2006-2007, to the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chennai.

10. The Engineer-In-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department in his letter tenth read above has sent proposal for revision of seniority of Assistant Engineers selected in the 1997-1998 batch included in the temporary lists of Assistant Engineers / Junior Engineers fit for promotion / appointment as Assistant Executive Engineers(Civil) approved during the year 2006-2007.

11. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department and decided to accept it. Accordingly, in supersession of the orders issued in the Government
