ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, the estimate of vacancy for the post of Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) in the Tamil Nadu

Engineering Service, Branch -I, Public Works for the year 2010-2011 had been fixed as 275 Nos.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued approving the temporary lists of Assistant Engineers / Junior Engineers fit for promotion / appointment for the post of Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) for the year 2010-2011 consisting of 130 Nos. of Assistant Engineers and 44 Nos. of Junior Engineers and they were subsequently promoted / appointed as Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) in Public Works Department in the Government Order third read above.

3. In continuation of the orders issued in the Government Orders second and third read above, in the Government Order fourth read above, orders have been issued approving supplementary temporary list of Assistant Engineers / Junior Engineers fit for promotion / appointment for the post of Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) for the year 2010-2011 consisting of 76 Nos. of Assistant Engineers and 25 Nos. of Junior Engineers and they were subsequently promoted / appointed as Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) in Public Works Department in the Government Order fifth read above.

4. In the Government Orders sixth to ninth read above, orders have been issued for restoration of seniority in respect of 5 Nos. of Junior Engineers in the post of Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) in the respective places.

5. Thiru. S. Manikandan and 8 others who were selected by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in the 1997-1998 batch, have filed Writ Petition No. 46868 of 2006 before the High Court of Madras with a prayer to direct the TNPSC to revise their seniority in the post of Assistant Engineer in Public Works Department as per the practice followed earlier to 1996 in assigning the ranks which was dismissed by Common Order dated 18.10.2012 on the sole ground that the petitioners were guilty of delay and laches.

6. Aggrieved by the above order, the Writ Petitioners have filed a Writ Appeal. The Division Bench of Madras High Court in its Common Order dated 31.3.2015 passed in W.A. No. 2705, 2730, 2731 of 2012, 2394 and 1033 of 2013 allowed the Writ Appeals and directed the official respondents to take the rank assigned by the Service Commission to the selectees, as the basis for fixation of seniority and issue appropriate orders within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

7. The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, preferred SLP (Civil) No. 22094 – 22098 of 2015 (SLP (C) No. 2886 of 2016) against the above order of the Division Bench dated 31.3.2015 in the Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its Order dated 22.1.2016 has held that, "after the emergence of the judgment in *Bimlesh Tanwar*, the

fundamental principle relating to drawal of seniority list was that it should be based on merit list of selection and that the list drawn based on roster point can have no application for the purpose of seniority list. As the said fundamental principle was applied by the High Court in passing the impugned judgment, we do not find any merit in these special leave petitions. The special leave petitions were dismissed".

8. The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has preferred Review Petition on the above orders before the Supreme Court of India and these Review Petitions were also dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 25.8.2020.

9. Certain contempt petitions were filed by the selectees, who were aggrieved by non revision of the seniority list in the Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order tenth read above in Civil Appeal No. 4954 of 2016 and batch cases dated 1.10.2021 has passed the following orders:-

"28. We therefore direct the respondents to revise and publish the seniority list of the selectees, who were selected in the selection process conducted in pursuance of the notification issued by TNPSC dated 10th September 1999, strictly on the basis of the merit determined by it in the selection process and not on the basis of the roster point. The same shall be done within a period of 12 weeks from the date of this order".

10. ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, the estimate of vacancy for the post of Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) in the Tamil Nadu

Engineering Service, Branch -I, Public Works for the year 2013-2014 had been fixed as 169 Nos.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued approving the temporary lists of Assistant Engineers / Junior Engineers fit for promotion / appointment for the post of Assistant Executive Engineers(Civil) for the year 2013-2014 consisting of 127 Nos. of Assistant Engineers and 41 Nos. of Junior Engineers and in the Government Order third read above, amendment was issued to include one number of Junior Engineer at Sl. No. 42 and they were subsequently promoted / appointed as Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) in Public Works Department in Government Order fourth read above.

3. In the Government Orders fifth and sixth read above, orders have been issued for restoration of seniority in respect of 2 Nos. of Junior Engineers in the post of Assistant Executive Engineer (Civil) in the respective place.

4. Thiru. S. Manikandan and 8 others who were selected by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in the 1997-1998 batch, have filed Writ Petition No. 46868 of 2006 before the High Court of Madras with a prayer to direct the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission to revise their seniority in the post of Assistant Engineer in Public Works Department as per the practice followed earlier to 1996 in assigning the ranks which was dismissed by Common Order dated 18.10.2012 on the sole ground that the petitioners were guilty of delay and laches.

5. Aggrieved by the above order, the Writ Petitioners have filed a Writ Appeal. The Division Bench of Madras High Court in its Common Order dated 31.3.2015 passed in W.A. No. 2705, 2730, 2731 of 2012, 2394 and 1033 of 2013 allowed the Writ Appeals and directed the official respondents to take the rank assigned by the Service Commission to the selectees, as the basis for fixation of seniority and issue appropriate orders within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

6. The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, preferred SLP (Civil) No. 22094 – 22098 of 2015 (SLP (C) No. 2886 of 2016) against the above order of the Division Bench dated 31.3.2015 in the Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its Order dated 22.1.2016 has held that, *"after the emergence of the judgment in Bimlesh Tanwar, the fundamental principle relating to drawl of seniority list was that it should be based on merit list of selection and that the list drawn based on roster point can have no application for the purpose of seniority list. As the said fundamental principle was applied by the High Court in passing the impugned judgment, we do not find any merit in these special leave petitions. The special leave petitions were dismissed"*.

7. The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has preferred Review Petition on the above orders before the Supreme Court of India and these Review Petitions were also dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 25.8.2020.

8. Certain contempt petitions were filed by the selectees, who were aggrieved by non revision of the seniority list in the Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order seventh read above in Contempt Petition Civil Appeal No.4954 of 2016, dated 01.10.2021 has passed the following orders:-

"28. We therefore direct the respondents to revise and publish the seniority list of the selectees, who were selected in the selection process conducted in pursuance of the notification issued by TNPSC dated 10th September 1999, strictly on the basis of the merit determined by it in the selection process and not on the basis of the roster point. The same shall be done within a period of 12 weeks from the date of this order".

2. With reference to the Government Letter 3rd cited, the Senior Divisional Manager, United India Insurance Company Limited in the reference fourth cited as furnished the following reply:

- i. The cashless facility is successfully implemented in all the approved hospitals across Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Bengaluru, Thiruvananthapuram and New Delhi undertaken by the Third Party Administrators for agreed package rates for the accredited treatments / surgeries in the approved hospitals in 2012 and the same is followed till date.

- ii. It is pointed out that wherever the collection of deposit amount or excess amount beyond the agreed package rate is brought to the knowledge of the Third Party Administrator before the discharge of patients, Third Party Administrator Service Provider has interfered and sorted out the issued.
- iii. The subscription made to the scheme by employee is Rs.300/- P.M. (Rs.295/- subscription for NHIS + Rs.5/- Contribution for corpus fund) for a block period of 4 years from 01.07.2021 to 30.06.2025.

Based on the announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on the floor of the Legislative Assembly under Rule 110 of LAS Rules on 07.09.2021, to extend medical assistance to the dependent children of Government employees without any age restrictions, the United India Insurance Company Limited which is implementing New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 was requested to quote the additional premium to cover the dependent children without any age limit under the Scheme and also create a help desk for hassle free treatment of employees. The Senior Divisional Manager, United India Insurance Company Limited has furnished the coverage of Dependents Children of the Government Employees under New Health Insurance Scheme 2021 subject to fulfillment of following conditions: -

- i. Dependent Children is unemployed and unmarried
- ii. Pursuing higher studies and dependent on employee
- iii. Divorced female child without any children and dependent on the employee.
- iv. Mentally disabled children

Further, based on the proposal of United India Insurance Company Limited, orders have been issued in the reference third read above among others notifying the details of Nodal Officers in help desk stationed in Top 50 hospitals for the benefit of all the employees covered under the New Health Insurance Scheme 2021.

4. The United India Insurance Company Limited in its letter dated 02.12.2021, considering the long standing relations with the Government, quoted a nominal premium of Rs.20/- + GST per family per annum to cover the dependent children of Government employees without age restriction from the date of receipt of the additional premium. The definition of dependent children would include the following in addition to what has been stated in the Government Order first read above.

- i. Unemployed children
- ii. Children pursuing higher studies
- iii. Unmarried / legally divorced daughters who are dependent on the employee
- iv. Mentally handicapped children.
- v. Declaration on the dependency of the child would be furnished by the concerned employee at the time of treatment / claim.

4. In the Government Order fourth read above, amendments have been issued to the Tamil Nadu Government Business Rules, 1978 wherein the

subjects relating to "Water Resources" which have been already existed under the heading "Public Works Department" have been omitted and those subjects have been inserted under the heading "Water Resources Department", separately.

5. In the Government Order fifth read above, orders have been issued for formation of a separate General Unit in the office of the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai to deal with all establishment matters of Public Works Department.

6. In the Government Order sixth read above, orders have been issued stipulating guidelines for the vertical separation of the Department into Public Works Department and Water Resources Department.
